Use

REAL TIME
captions.

Increase accessibility by using presentation software that creates real time captions, such as Google Slides and Powerpoint.



REPEAT

or paraphrase information
said by others in class.

in the front of the classroom.

Use

visuals

to supplement content.

To recap:

- Reduce background noise as much as possible.
- Face your students so they can see your lips.
- Use real time captions to help with comprehension.
- Repeat/paraphrase what is being said in class discussions.
- Use visuals to supplement spoken content.
- Provide preferential seating at the front of the class.
