

Dress Loud Day is coming this May and you can join in on the fun!

VOICE for deaf and hard of hearing children is having Dress Loud Day on May 8, 2020 (or any day you would like during the month of May) and we invite you to join us in our mission to ensure that all children who are deaf or hard of hearing have access to the services they need to teach them to listen and speak.

Every May is speech & hearing awareness month across Canada. This month is filled with events & conferences that share & spread awareness of children who are deaf or hard of hearing. Hearing loss is an “invisible” disability affecting children and adults. Approximately 3 in every 1,000 children are born with hearing loss or will develop a hearing loss in their childhood which significantly affects their ability to learn. According to Statistics Canada, more than one million adults across the country reported having a hearing-related disability.

About Dress Loud Day:

What is it? Dress Loud Day is an opportunity to educate students and educators that deaf or hard of hearing kids listen, speak and attend mainstream schools. Dress Loud Day is about generating awareness on how the needs of deaf or hard of hearing children can be met and how ideal listening environments can be created in the classroom. Participants donate a toonie (or more) and wear their loudest, wildest, wackiest shirts, ties, or other clothing.

When is it? Any day in May, 2020!
